Making the Emerald City

Demonstrate a range of joining techniques (such as gluing, hinges or combining materials to strengthen)

Do you need to measure something? Do you need to cut or tear your materials? Will glue work or do you need tape?

- Everything in the Emerald City is green so try and make your building as green as possible!
