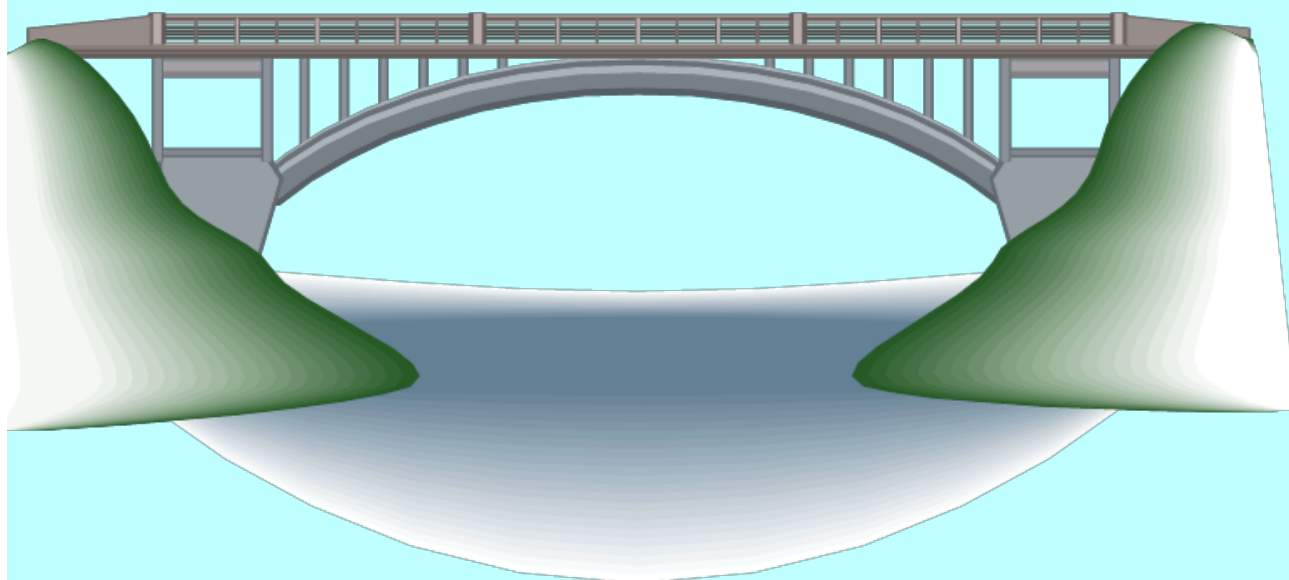


## Success Criteria
