Wednesday: L.O. To use my senses to describe

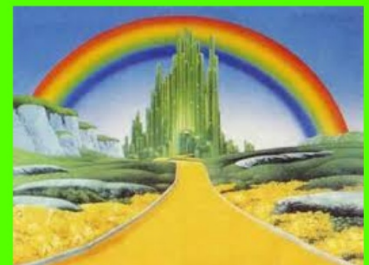
Today, we're going to think about how our senses can help make our writing really exciting.
